

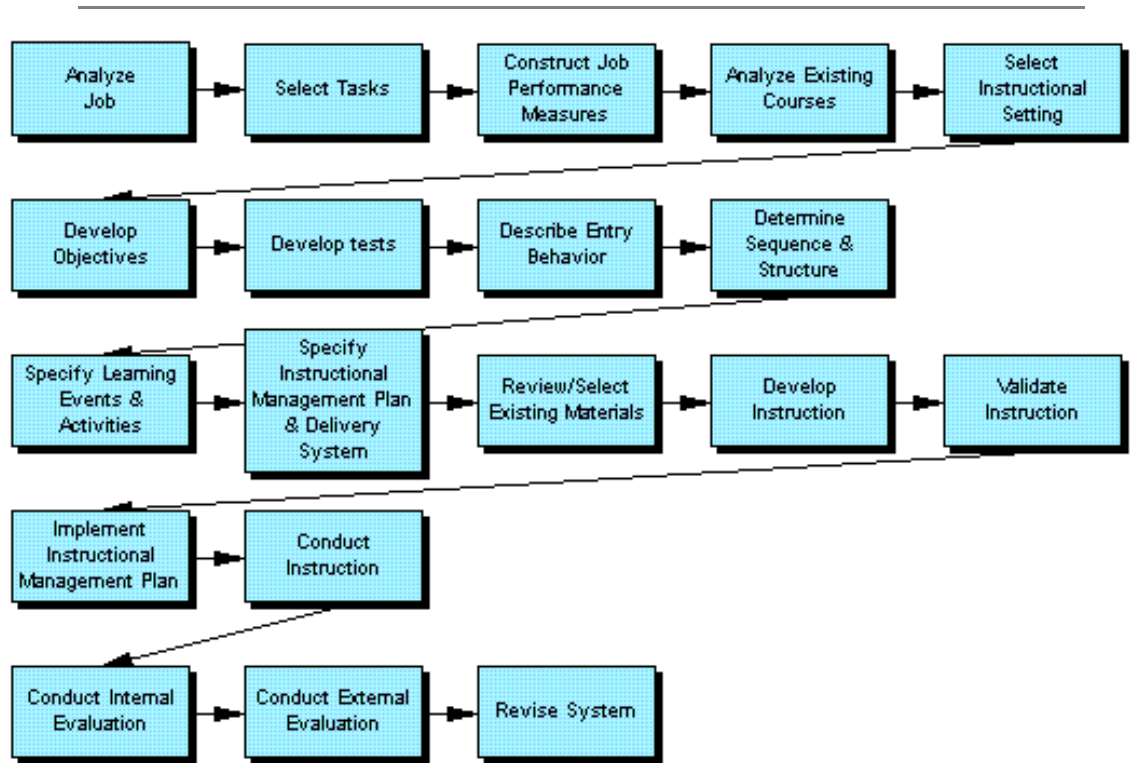

Military ISD Model

Technically this model is the *Interservice Procedures for Instructional Systems Development*. Most people just call it the *Military ISD Model*. This ISD model was approved by the Joint Chiefs of Staff in 1975 to govern all military education and training. It became the grandfather for most ISD models that followed.

The first row is the Analysis Phase; the second row is the Design Phase; the third row is the Development Phase; the fourth row is the Implementation Phase; and the fifth row is the Evaluation Phase. This model is geared for training. It starts with analyzing the work people perform on their jobs, not with any needs assessment. It expects training as the solution since it does not include any performance analysis. Still a quarter century later, much of this model remains appropriate. It is still the primary model for ISD.
